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## **ARH 2000 Art Appreciation**

**Credit Hours:** 3

**Prerequisites:** Appropriate test scores in reading and writing or exemption from placement testing

**General Education Category:** Communications Skills Gen Ed, Humanities

The course provides a foundation for appreciation of the visual arts, through an introduction to selected global historical examples, the formal language of the visual arts, theoretical and critical perspectives, aesthetics, and a survey of contemporary arts with an emphasis on diversity.
