

COSMETOLOGY LAB (COSL)

COSL 0080 Cosmetology I

Clock Hours: 240

Lab Fee: Yes

Orientation to cosmetology field. Student will use the classroom and laboratory facilities and develop basic skills, techniques, and preparation to work on clients. This course focuses on theoretical and practical principles of cosmetology as required by the State Board of Cosmetology to include proper sanitation, universal precautions, scalp diseases and disorders, water chemistry and effects on shampoos and conditioners, hair sculpting, hair arranging and laboratory practices.

COSL 0081 Cosmetology II

Clock Hours: 240

Prerequisites: COSL 0080 with a grade of "C" or higher

Lab Fee: Yes

This course is a continuation of basic skills and concept development from Cosmetology I. This course focuses on theoretical and practical principles of correct chemical application, proper chemical mixing techniques, braiding, client communication, knowledge of multi-textural hair and types, correct product selection for chemical restructuring of hair, wigs, types of braids, and braided extension hair enhancements.

COSL 0082 Cosmetology III

Clock Hours: 240

Prerequisites: COSL 0080 and COSL 0081 with a grade of "C" or higher

Lab Fee: Yes

This course is designed to provide competencies in manicuring and pedicuring, and in applying artificial nails and nail wraps. Topics include: supply and equipment selection, sanitation procedures, and designated procedure performance. This course will also provide instruction in all types of hair coloring and bleaching; analysis of hair and scalp, predisposition test performance, and correct supply and equipment selection.

COSL 0083 Cosmetology IV

Clock Hours: 240

Prerequisites: COSL 0080, COSL 0081, COSL 0082 all with a grade of "C" or higher

Lab Fee: Yes

Application of techniques in salon services demonstrated on live models and mannequins.

COSL 0084 Cosmetology V

Clock Hours: 240

Prerequisites: COSL 0080, COSL 0081, COSL 0082, and COSL 0083 all with a grade of "C" or higher

Lab Fee: Yes

Lab provides salon experience with patrons in hair and scalp care using principles of design in styling and preliminary diagnostic techniques used in the care of the hair and scalp prior to and following chemical treatment.
