**ECO 2013 Principles of Economics 1 (Macroeconomics)****Credit Hours:** 3**General Education Category:** Social Science CORE COURSE

Introduction to the general theories of economics with practical applications. Topics include determination of price, national income accounting, economic stabilization, growth, money and banking, and monetary policy. This course is a state-designated core course. Course meets General Education requirement.

**ECO 2023 Principles of Economics 2 (Microeconomics)****Credit Hours:** 3

This course is an introduction to basic microeconomic concepts. Topics include market outcomes using supply and demand, elasticity, consumer behavior, market structures, and resource markets.

**ECO 2948 Service-Learning Field Studies 1****Credit Hours:** 1

This course gives students opportunity to understand the relationship of theory to practice through participation in a service-learning experience. Students are required to complete 20 hours of volunteer work, a service-learning contract, and an oral and written reflection of the experience.
