

# ECONOMICS (ECO)

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## **ECO 2013 Principles of Economics 1 (Macroeconomics)**

**Credit Hours:** 3

**General Education Category:** Social/Behavioral General Ed, Social Science  
Core Course

In this course, students will learn the foundations of macroeconomics as the branch of economics concerned with how decision-making, in an environment of scarcity, maps onto the aggregate economy. Students will examine theories and evidence related the following core set of topics: national income determination, money, monetary and fiscal policy, macroeconomic conditions, international trade and the balance of payments, and economic growth and development. This is a state-designated general education core course.

## **ECO 2023 Principles of Economics 2 (Microeconomics)**

**Credit Hours:** 3

This course is an introduction to basic microeconomic concepts. Topics include market outcomes using supply and demand, elasticity, consumer behavior, market structures, and resource markets.

## **ECO 2948 Service Learning Field Studies 1**

**Credit Hours:** 1

This course gives students opportunity to understand the relationship of theory to practice through participation in a service-learning experience. Students are required to complete 20 hours of volunteer work, a service-learning contract, and an oral and written reflection of the experience.
